

COVID-19 UPDATE

We are working within government guidelines to provide a safe environment by implementing thorough precautions and preventions in response to COVID-19.

Please note that we also adhere to each individual school's COVID-19 policies and procedures.

All bookings can be cancelled or rescheduled at no cost if unforeseen COVID-19 circumstances arise.

Our policies will be regularly updated to reflect ongoing changes in government announcements.

Precautions and Preventions:

Hygiene: We follow Australian government guidelines regarding hygiene practices. All our equipment is cleaned thoroughly after each use with hospital-grade disinfectant wipes and sprays. Presenters are equipped with hand sanitiser to use regularly during the day.

Symptoms: If for any reason presenters exhibit cold or flu-like symptoms, we will immediately let the school know so that other arrangements can be made. It is asked that if any students exhibit cold or flu-like symptoms, that they are asked to refrain from attending the session.

Physical Distancing: Whilst the Australian government suggests that school students do not need to follow strict adult physical distancing guidelines, we will apply safe distancing practices where practical, and in line with each individual school's policies.

Class/Session Sizes: We recommend that schools book our Superdome if possible. Session and class sizes can be modified to adhere to government and school policies.
